“Municipal and Transportation Improvement Fund.”

Chairman Ludwig stated as I have done in the past I would like to inform the committee members that this is for a technical review and ask the City Solicitor if in his opinion this ordinance is technically correct.

Thomas Arnold, Deputy Solicitor, responded I believe that it is. This particular ordinance was put before the board because under the state statute we are supposed to have a separate fund for the funds collected. This ordinance is to set up that fund for the fees to be deposited in so that they are separately accounted for.

Chairman Ludwig asked hasn't this been in place for some time?

Mr. Arnold answered we have been collecting the fee for some period of time but apparently the separate account was never set up. The fees have been appropriately accounted for and have not been misdirected or misspent but we were supposed to have a separate fund and that is what this is.

On motion of Alderman Levasseur, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted that the ordinance amendment ought to pass and be referred to the Committee on Accounts, Enrollment and Revenue Administration.

There being no further business, on motion of Alderman Levasseur, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted to adjourn.
